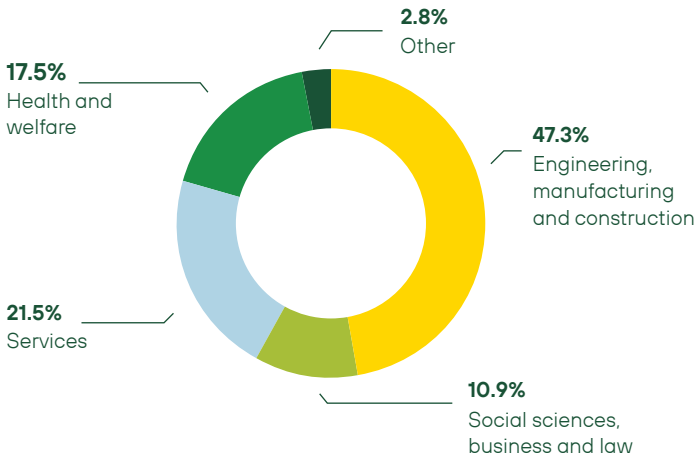
Alytus is the only region in Lithuania which has a specialized regional career development center, called "Karjeras". This center is a great collaboration

platform between municipal, business, education and labour market entities. "Karjeras" is going to be a pillar of preparing the right talent in the region.

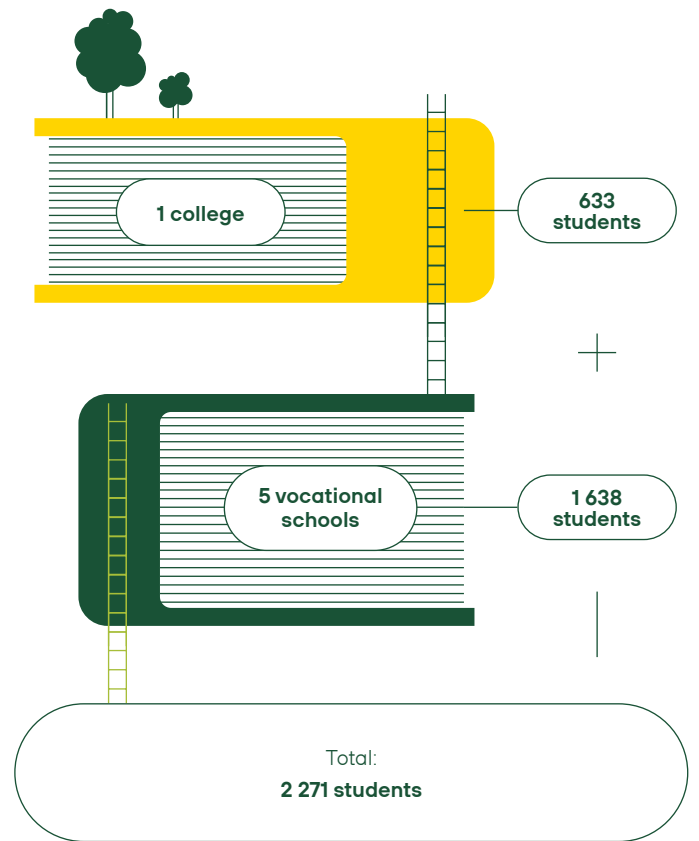

In 2017, Alytus College and the medical SPA Eglės sanatorium signed a cooperation agreement to collaborate in developing study programs

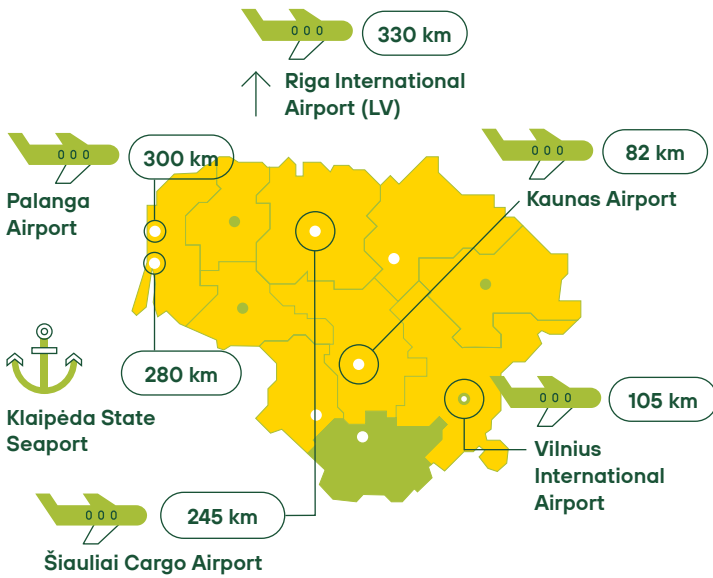
in the biomedical field, introducing new specializations in areas of mutual interest, organizing student internships and other activities.

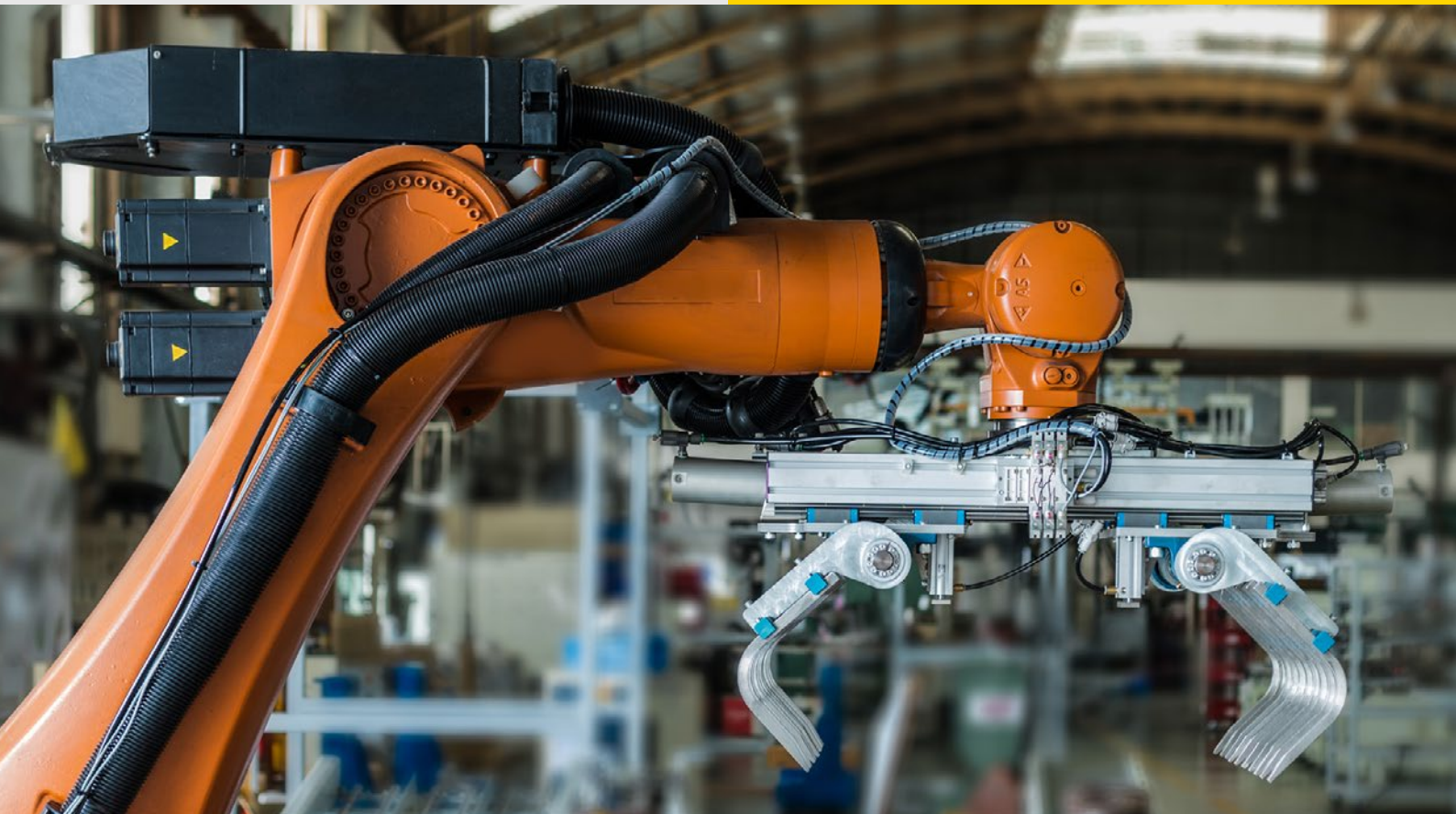
