- The company also has a Design & Development team, a testing lab, a paint shop, an automated wheels line, a cargo bikes production line, and a warehouse for 14,000 bikes.

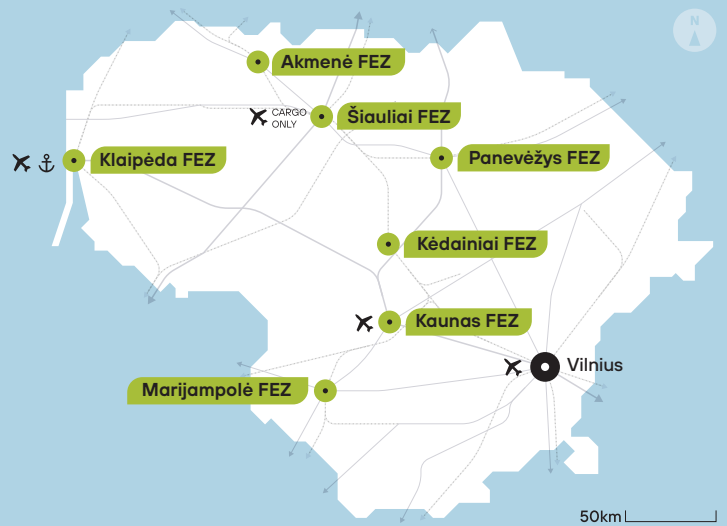
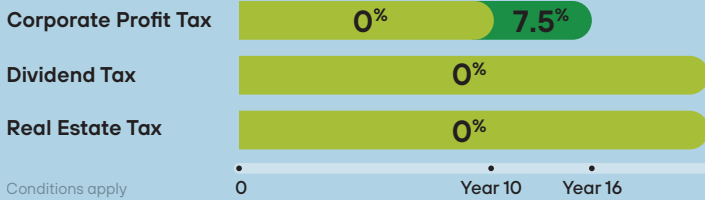


- Pon.Bike, the world's leading bicycle company, will open a new manufacturing facility in Kėdainiai in 2024

Lithuania's seven Free Economic Zones provide unbeatable conditions for business development. They offer ready-to-build industrial sites with physical and/or legal infrastructure, support services, and tax incentives.



Additional government subsidies

Subsidy Type	Details	Benefit
Invest LT+	For investments into new buildings and machinery	up to 50%
Apprenticeship	For covering apprenticeship costs	up to 70%
Green Corridor	For investments larger than €20M, 150 FTE	0% CIT + other benefits

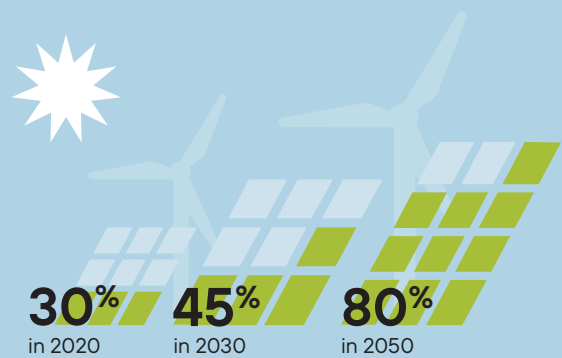
