Green energy (biomass, wind power, hydropower, and solar energy) is produced widely in the region, ensuring reduced heating costs for local businesses.

Moreover, an international baccalaureate class, as well as bilingual kindergarten groups are established in Tauragé.

The municipality has priority programs in science, engineering, natural sciences, information technology, robotics and civil education, which are implemented in rural areas. Priorities have been identified in order to popularize relevant scientific fields in rural areas.

Tauragė Municipality has signed an agreement with Klaipėda University (KU) in order to establish a University gymnasium. This agreement brings mutually beneficial co-operation in combining the research, study and cultural-artistic activities of KU and the needs and interests of the Tauragė region's strategic development. It is intended to promote a closer and more effective partnership between local authorities and KU.
