








It offers a world-class environment and infrastructure for business, a lively arts and cultural scene, a charming UNESCO-listed Old Town, and a city so green it feels like you are living in a forest - all less than a 3-hour flight from most major European capitals.

Consequently, Vilnius has been ranked 9th in the world for work-life balance (Business Insider, 2016) and 98% of residents are happy with life in Vilnius (European Commission survey).

There are many well-rated restaurants and cozy cafes, many of which have atmospheres well suited to business meetings and networking. Most good restaurants in the city endeavor to use only locally sourced organic produce, taking inspiration from the seasons and adding a contemporary twist to traditional Lithuanian recipes.
